At the Stichtse Vrije School, a regional secondary school for Waldorf education in the central province of Utrecht in the Netherlands, the pupils of the top two classes each year participate in a work experience project. The main part of the project is formed by two weeks of active participation in a work environment. Our pupils are asked to independently search for a firm or institution which may provide such experience by means of a practical placement. This letter is meant to support their search. Before final arrangements with a suitable firm or institution can be made, the pupils have to receive a formal consent of the school's project tutor.

The yearly work experience projects are organised and prepared for in the lessons "Society Studies". The main object of the project in class 12(ages 17 & 18) is to participate in organisations which are based on an idealistic background. Meeting people who are trying to implement their ideals in their daily work can be very stimulating for these pupils, who are about to leave school. Gaining insight in these ideals and the variety of hurdles and rewards you encounter in the implementation is the main theme of the project. Active participation in the daily work and the social setting which belongs to it, facilitates this process.

This school-year, the project will take place from **March 2th to April 06th 2012**. We would be very pleased if you would be willing to consider the request of our pupil.
